## **INVITATION OF BIDS** **Open Advertised National Bidding Notice**

*(Authorized under Section 16 of the Public Procurement Act 2006)*

(1) The District Council of Savanne is inviting bids for the Year 2019-2020 from local and qualified bidders in respect of **The Construction of a Village Hall at Tyack (DCS/OAB/W005/19-20)**. The eligibility criteria has been laid down in the bidding document.

Bidders are requested to submit their bid in plain sealed envelopes addressed to the Chief Executive and clearly marked "**DCS/OAB/W005/19-20 – The Construction of a Village Hall at Tyack**" and deposit in the Bid Box situated at the Administration Department, District Council Headquarters, Lady Barkly Street, Souillac not later than **Thursday 19 March 2020 at 13.30 hrs.** Bids should not be sent by Post and no bid will be accepted after the closing date and time. Electronic bidding shall not be permitted.

### (5) **Acceptance of Bids**

The District Council of Savanne reserves the right to:

- (a) accept or reject any bid;
- (b) to split the contract and
- (c) to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract.

### (6) **Opening of Bids**

Bids will be opened physically in the presence of bidders / bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person, in the Council Room of the District Council at **13.45 hrs (local time) on the same day, i.e., Thursday 19 March 2020.**
